



# Droitwich Spa Angling Club



## Club Rules

- 1) All members must complete a new membership form and include their Environmental Agency Licence Number.
- 2) All Guest Day Tickets must be paid in advance of fishing: contact a member of the club's Committee.
- 3) No bloodworm or joker.

## River Avon, Twyning

- 1) Guests will be allowed to fish twice in club contest per year.
- 2) No litter to be left behind. The field is a nature reserve and failure to follow this simple rule will result in the club being removed from the fishery.
- 3) No Day Tickets
- 4) Night fishing is not permitted. Fishing is from dawn to dusk only.

## Droitwich Canal

- 1) Disable anglers have priority on the platforms. They must be made available if a disabled angler requires a platform.
- 2) The canal must be kept litter free at all times and respect for other canal users must be upheld by all club members at all times.
- 3) No night fishing is permitted on the canal.

## Dissolution


- 1) If at any General Meeting a resolution be passed calling for the dissolution of the Club, the Secretary shall immediately convene a Special General Meeting of the Club to be held no less than month thereafter to discuss and vote on the resolution.
- 2) If, at that Special General Meeting, the resolution is carried by at least two-thirds of the Full Members present, the General Committee shall thereupon, or at such a date as shall have been specified in the resolution, proceed to realise the assets of the Club and discharge all debts and liabilities of the Club.





- 3) After discharging all debts and liabilities of the Club, the remaining assets shall not be paid nor distributed amongst the Full Members of the Club, but shall be given or transferred to some other voluntary organisation having objects similar to those of the Club.

## Club Rules and Regulations

### Membership Requirements

All individuals wishing to join the club must complete a new membership form. It is compulsory for members to provide their Environmental Agency Licence Number as part of this process.

### Guest Day Tickets

All Guest Day Tickets must be purchased before any fishing activity takes place. To obtain a ticket, please contact a member of the club's Committee. Please note that the use of bloodworm or joker as bait is strictly prohibited.

### River Avon, Twyning: Rules and Guidelines

Guests are permitted to fish in club contests on the River Avon, Twyning, a maximum of two times per year. It is mandatory that no litter is left behind under any circumstances, as the field is designated a nature reserve. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in the club being excluded from the fishery.

Day Tickets are not available for this location. Night fishing is not allowed; fishing is permitted only from dawn to dusk.

### Droitwich Canal: Rules and Guidelines

Disabled anglers are given priority use of the fishing platforms. If a disabled angler requires access to a platform, it must be made available to them. The canal environment must be kept free from litter at all times, and all club members are expected to show respect towards other users of the canal. Night fishing on the canal is strictly prohibited.

### Dissolution of the Club

Should a resolution be passed at any General Meeting calling for the dissolution of the Club, the Secretary is required to immediately arrange a Special General Meeting. This meeting must be held no less than one month after the resolution is passed, and its purpose will be to discuss and vote on the matter of dissolution.

If, at the Special General Meeting, the resolution is approved by at least two-thirds of the Full Members present, the General Committee will proceed, either immediately or on a date specified in the resolution, to realise the assets of the Club and settle all debts and liabilities.

Once all debts and liabilities have been discharged, any remaining assets must not be distributed among the Full Members. Instead, these assets should be transferred or given to another voluntary organisation with objectives similar to those of the Club.
