Match Rules

- 1) Names of anglers to be booked in with Match Secretary no later than 7.30pm on the Thursday evening before each match, allowing guests to book in on the Friday
- 2) Summer matches draw time 8.30am. Fishing 9.30am to 2.30pm
- 3) Winter matches draw time 8.45am. Fishing 10.00am to 3.00pm
- 4) All pool matches are two keep nets; one silver and one carp
- 5) Anglers must fish to fishery rules. Ask the Match Secretary for details of venues
- 6) No additional bait to be brought to pegs once match has started
- 7) The person who is nominated to weigh in must participate
- 8) Pegging of home canal will include Section 1, 2, 3, 4 sections only – bring a trolley
- 9) Matches at Porters Mill Canal Section 4: This is reserved for disabled and pleasure fishing. This rule can be amended by the Committee at any time should the situation dictate
- 10) Bloodworm and Joker are not permitted on our venues.
- 11) Team Challenge: Each team must nominate a Team Captain who is responsible for their team and ensuring they weigh in.

Match Rules

Booking Procedures

All anglers wishing to participate in a match must book in with the Match Secretary no later than 19:30 on the Thursday evening prior to each match. This early booking allows guests to register for the event on the Friday.

Match Timings

Summer Matches

The draw for summer matches will take place at 08:30. Fishing will commence at 09:30 and conclude at 14:30.

Winter Matches

The draw for winter matches will be held at 08:45, with fishing beginning at 10:00 and finishing at 15:00.

Equipment and Pools

All pool matches require anglers to use two keep nets: one designated for silver fish and one for carp.

Match Conduct and Fishery Rules

Anglers are required to adhere strictly to fishery rules during matches. For specific details concerning venues, participants should consult the Match Secretary.

Once a match has commenced, no additional bait may be brought to pegs by any angler.

Weigh-In Procedures

The individual nominated for the weigh-in must actively participate in the process.

Pegging and Venue Access

Pegging of the home canal will be restricted to Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 only. Anglers are advised to bring a trolley for convenience.

At Porters Mill Canal, Section 4 is reserved exclusively for disabled and pleasure fishing. The Committee reserves the right to amend this rule at any time should circumstances require.

Bait Restrictions

The use of bloodworm and joker is strictly prohibited at all club venues.

Team Challenge Regulations

For team challenge events, each team must appoint a Team Captain. The Team Captain is responsible for overseeing the team and ensuring all members participate in the weigh-in.
